EVENT RULES

1. The players must kick-off with a backward pass at the beginning of each half and after every goal is scored.
2. In case of a tie after full time the golden goal concept will be used to determine the winner.
3. It is not allowed to score a goal from a direct goal kick.
4. Direct goal from corners is NOT ALLOWED.
5. Players may not select any fictional All-Star teams (e.g. Classic 11).
6. If a player is found to be intentionally delaying the game time by passing the ball around and clearly not attempting to score, he may be given a warning or lose by default at the Co-Ordinators discretion.
7. In case a disconnection occurs: A Co-Ordinator will confirm the exact score to that point (even if the ball is about to cross the goal line, the goal shall not count), and restart the match.
8. A Co-Ordinator will inform the players on exactly how many minutes must still be played in order to complete the match
